## **Gray Line of San Francisco's Napa & Sonoma Wine Country Tour**

California Wines are famous throughout the world and Gray Line of San Francisco offers a daily tour to beautiful Sonoma and Napa wine country in their luxury motor coaches. The first stop on the tour is only 45 minutes north of the Golden Gate Bridge in the heart of the Carneros region of Sonoma, famous for producing some of the finest Pino Noir grapes in California. Each Vineyard Grayline visits specializes in a different varietal of wine and the wine tasting is included in the tour price.

The tour continues through Sonoma and on to Napa Valley for more tour and tasting. At least three wineries are visited and then there is a stop for lunch in the heart of Napa in Yountville, famous for it's lovely location surrounded by vineyards and home of the Michelin Star restaurant the French Laundry and the famous Bouchon Bakery. There are several wine tasting rooms within walking distances and lovely shops and restaurants along the main street and in the V market place in the center of town.

It is a great day in the Wine country any time of year on Gray Line's luxury wine tour. In the spring wild flowers grow under the sprouting grapevines. In the summer the green vines heavy with grapes are surrounded by golden hills during the summer dry months. In the fall, when the grapes are being harvested and crushed, the grape leaves are multi colored and the whole valley is dotted in fall foliage. The winter months bring green hillsides with yellow mustards flowers and cozy wineries.
